

Cookies Policy

We use so-called cookies. Cookies are small, digital pieces of information that are saved on your computer or mobile devices (tablet and/or smartphone). These bits of technology are sent to your web browser when you visit an internet page. This information is sent back the next time you visit this page. These cookies are functional and do not have any marketing purpose.

We use session cookies, which contains information that is stored in a temporary memory location and then subsequently deleted after the session is completed or the web browser is closed. This cookie stores information that the user has inputted and tracks the movements of the user within the website.

Would you rather not receive cookies? You can flag this in your browser settings. You must do this on each computer/tablet/smartphone that you use. Therefore, we recommend that you set your preferences immediately; in every browser and on all your devices. The method varies depending on your browser. Google Analytics:

We use Google Analytics: The anonymised data from Google Analytics helps us to collect our website's statistical data. This data provides us with a clear picture of aspects such as visitor flow, traffic sources and page views, so we can anticipate trends when optimising our website.

The information that Google collects is anonymised. Your IP address will not be shared. Google hosts and stores the information on servers in the United States. Google states that it complies with the Privacy Shield principles and has joined the United States Department of Commerce's Privacy Shield programme. This implies that a suitable level of protection is in place should personal data be processed.
